Requirements

Seniors:

Minimum age 17 (participants need to be born in or before 2007), and a minimum of 1st Kyu.

Cadets:

Minimum age 12 (participants need to be born from 2012-2007), and a minimum of 3rd Kyu.

Participation Limit

The competition is limited to a maximum of 100 registrations in total (excluding the finals). The medalists of the German National Kata Championships 2024 can participate in any case. All other registrations will be considered in order of the date they are received.

Deadline

Sunday 22nd of September 2024, with simultaneous payment of the participation fee. Registration is subject to closing once the maximum number of participants has been reached.

Competition Formula The German Kata Open will be judged according to the official IJF Kata Competition rules.
Each participant can compete in a maximum of 2 different kata. It is not allowed to compete in the same kata more than once.

If the number of participating couples in one kata is less than 7, there will be only one round and no final. The ranking after this round will be the basis for awarding the medals.

If the number is between 7 and 11 participating couples, there will be a preliminary round with one pool and the best 4 couples will be qualified for the final.

If there are 12 or more couples, there will be a preliminary round with two pools and one final. After the preliminary round the top 3 couples from each pool will be qualified for the final.

If there are 2 pools the top 4 finalists of the German National Kata Championships 2024 will be allocated to the pools in the following way:

- Pool A:
1st place and 3rd place of the German National Kata Championships 2024
- Pool B:
2nd place and 4th place of the German National Kata Championships 2024.

A draw will be used to allocate all other participants to their preliminary pools.

The starting order within the preliminaries and finals is decided by the draw. The starting order will not be changed for athletes participating in a second kata.

Note For Kime no kata and Kodokan Goshin jutsu only wooden imitations of the weapons are allowed.

Backnumbers German participants need the official German DJB backnumbers.
Foreign participants need the official EJU/IJF backnumbers.

Competition licence Applies only to German participants, please read the German version of the outlines!

Awards The best three couples for each kata will be awarded medals or equivalent awards. Certificates will be issued for all participants.

Data Privacy By registering participants consent to the electronic storage of their personal data relevant to the competition as well as the publication thereof in bulletins, on websites or in any other documents published by the DJB or its subdivisions. The consent also applies to the publication of print, picture or video documentation and to the use for education purposes.
